The Tasting Garden - Storey Gardens Questionnaire

The Tasting Garden was created in 1998 by Mark Dion, an internationally renowned environmental artist. It is an orchard containing old varieties of fruit trees and paths laid out as branches of a tree. The plinths standing in front of each tree used to bear a bronze sculpture of its fruit, these were stolen in 2006. Extinct varieties are marked by memorial stones. The small folly, workshed containing traditional gardening equipment, is a monument to the people who produced the varieties of fruit trees that are part of our heritage.

The Friends of the Storey Gardens are seeking Heritage Lottery Funding (HLF) to restore The Tasting Garden back to its original glory as a widely recognised artwork.
